The Committee is prepared to recommend two proposed changes to the Constitution and several practical changes related to the Bylaws. The proposed changes were presented at the March 11 Business Meeting and will be discussed and voted on at the next Business Meeting.

The proposed changes to the Constitution are given below. They are required to be presented in the <u>Barcelona Banner</u>. Changes to the Bylaws are found in the revised Constitution and Bylaws document available outside the Sanctuary and in the Church Offices.

Article III, Section 3: "Persons who request membership in this church shall receive a packet containing its Covenant and Constitution and should participate in membership orientation directed conducted by the Council of Deacons, the Pastor, other Staff Members and/or Committee chairs. Requests for membership will be accepted at any regular service. Voting on membership will be only at business meetings."
