The Wonder of Christmas

When the shepherds heard the announcement of the first Christmas,

they were filled with amazement. They came "with haste" to discover baby Jesus lying in a manger. When word began to make the rounds, "all that heard it wondered at those things" (Luke 2:18). It has been that way ever since.


