### **Space Study Committee Report and Recommendations**



Our Space Study Committee has met regularly and prayerfully since February 2016 to discuss the future needs of our church. Early on, a demographic study was done by personnel from the Arkansas Baptist Convention. The study concluded that on the western side of the Village where we are located a significant number of people can be identified. Many are not affiliated with any church. Also, a large number of the homes in our area are being occupied by younger families.

A few months ago the church identified several areas of consideration for further study. An expenditure of \$5,000 was approved for architectural support. With specific information in hand, the committee is now prepared to bring its report and recommendations to the congregation. Below is the schedule we will follow:
