### Church Budget Giving

The following analysis of budget giving for 2017 has been supplied by our Finance Office. As your Pastor, I do not know what individual families give. This is a matter between you and the Lord.

I do know what Jackie and I give, and we have faithfully given a tithe of our income to the church budget throughout our married life. Our contributions to special offerings (like Lot-tie Moon) and other charitable causes outside the church are over and above our tithe to the church budget. This is our conviction.

### Observations

Several observations can be made from the above information. First, many people give generously to the church budget. The amount is not important, but faithful giving is. Second, others give a small amount or nothing at all. Some who gave during 2017 are not giving now. Third, during the past year several generous givers have gone to be with the Lord. Others have relocated. At the same time, new members have come into the church and are giving faithfully. Even so, budget receipts, January through June in 2018 are down \$36,819 from the first six months in 2017. Total budget receipts for 2017 were \$604,534, the largest amount received in the church's history. Special offerings for the year totaled \$87,957. Fourth, unlike some churches, Barcelona Road is not dependent upon the financial support of a few wealthy families. Rather, we depend on a large number of families making faithful contributions.

### Conclusions

How can we address the shortfall in budget giving? First, current givers may be able to increase their giving. Second, those who don't give hopefully will be challenged to start giving. Third, we need to reach more new members to replace the ones we have lost. Fourth, we ought to make budget giving a priority. Special offerings have their place and are important but not at the expense of regular budget giving. When our budget giving is down, our mission giving to the Cooperative Program and Central Baptist Association are affected negatively, since they are based on a percentage of the total budget receipts. Finally, we can pray for our church and its financial needs.
