FROM MY HEART TO YOURS:

Sermon Series on Acts



On Sunday mornings and evenings beginning in September, I will preach a series of sermons from the early chapters of Acts. Thankfully, we have Four Gospels that tell us the story of Jesus; but there is only one history of the early church, The Acts of the Apostles. Of course, we can piece together certain events from the letters of Paul. However, we would be greatly impoverished spiritually if Luke had not written his second volume on the spread of Christianity from Jerusalem to the "end of the earth" (Acts 1:8).

My seminary professor, Dr. Frank Stagg, wrote The Book of Acts: The Early Struggle for an Unhindered Gospel. He observed that the last word in Acts is "unhinderedly," an adverb. What an unusual way to end a book! Yet the word "unhinderedly" epitomizes the message of Acts. The gospel of Jesus Christ is able to break down every barrier and to change the lives of all people.

Take time to read through Acts 1-12 reflectively and prayerfully as we explore the life and ministry of the earliest Christians.

Special Worship Experiences

On Sunday morning, September 16, we will observe the Lord's Supper. It will be the focus of our service. That Sunday evening, we will celebrate with our annual Church Picnic at Balboa Lake Pavilion. Bring lots of food and enjoy the fellowship. Then, on Sunday evening, September 23, new deacons will be ordained and installed to serve in the church year, beginning October 1.

Tips for Sharing your Faith

We are called to be witnesses. Here are some tips for sharing your faith.

1. Live the Christian life. Most people know we believe in Jesus Christ; but we need to show them He is believable.
2. Find small ways to help others. Christianity is not a badge but a servant's towel.
3. Pray for an opportunity to share Christ with those around you. Develop a list and pray daily for those you know.

4. Tell family, friends, and acquaintances what Christ means to you. Your "story" is the most effective way to witness.
5. Follow a simple Scriptural approach using John 3:16 or the Roman Road to Salvation (3:23; 6:23; 5:8; 10:9-10, 13).
6. Notice your daily traffic patterns. As you encounter people, invite them to attend church with you.

CANDY CANES NEEDED

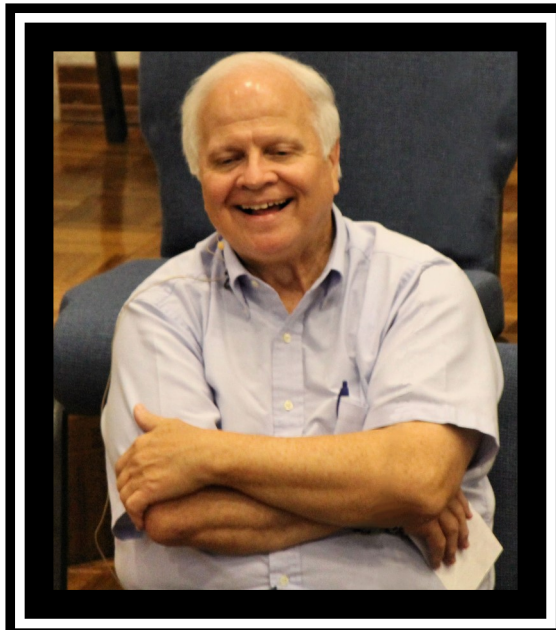

 2021.

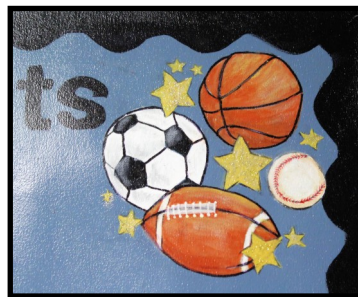
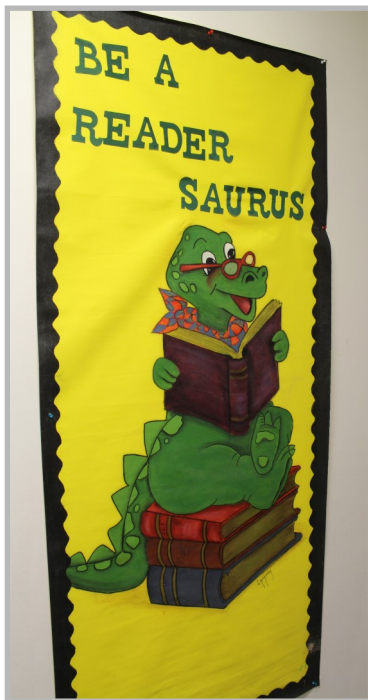
All ordained deacons, active
