### Duane Blakley Announces Retirement

It has been a privilege for me to serve with Duane for the past five and one-half years as your Pastor. During this time, he and I have carefully planned worship services that are Spirit-led and that meet the needs of the congregation. I have been amazed at and grateful for the way Duane has been able to integrate music and other elements of worship with the sermons I have preached. I have often said that when Duane can't find just the right music for a given service, he then writes something for us to sing that is appropriate and meaningful. Thank you, Duane, for your wonderful, creative gifts dedicated to the Lord.

### Call to Prayer

Paul commands, "Pray without ceasing" (1 Thessalonians 5:17). But is it really possible to pray continually? Jesus is our example. Someone has said,

"God has only one Son who lived without sin. But he has no sons or daughters who have lived without prayer." Prayer is a priority. As S. D. Gordon, one of my favorite writers put it, "You can do more than pray after you have prayed; but you can do no more than pray until you have prayed."

Jesus' life was punctuated by prayer. He prayed at his baptism. He prayed before meals. He prayed all night before calling his disciples. His prayer in Gethsemane was so intense that the sweat from his brow appeared as great drops of blood. He prayed more than once from the Cross. His was the greatest life ever lived. And he lived it by prayer.

Jesus reminded us that we "ought always to pray and not to faint" (Luke 11:1). The word "ought" implies moral obligation. Prayer is not just a privilege but a responsibility. If we do not "always" pray, we will fall by the wayside. We must persist in prayer. In the words of the familiar gospel hymn, "Oh, what peace we often forfeit, Oh, what needless pain we bear, All because we do not carry everything to God in prayer" (What a Friend We Have in Jesus).

6:00 PM**

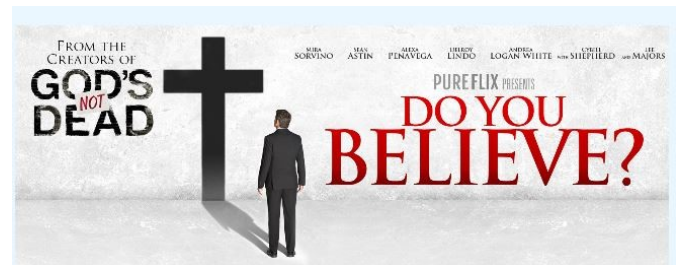
